13 14 15	WHEREAS the current administration has initiated a policy of separating parents from children when families arrive seeking asylum at the southern border of our nation.
16 17 18 19 20 21 22	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Delegates to the 151 st Annual Meeting of the Connecticut Conference, condemn in the strongest terms possible the outrageous, inhumane, and unjust treatment of those "strangers" seeking refuge at our southern border. The deliberate and cruel separation of infants and children from their parents must cease at once, and a more compassionate, kinder, and more just policy – one that reflects the "better angels" of our national nature – must take its place.
