WHEREAS Connecticut and the nation face a continued and increasing housing shortage, and

WHEREAS the present federal programs for the production of nonprofit housing are being utilized with increasing frequency by our churches and other organizations, and

WHEREAS present proposed guidelines circulated by the Federal Housing Administration (F.H.A.) put this program in extreme jeopardy,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Connecticut Conference of the United Church of Christ affirms its support of church and other organizations' sponsorship of non-profit housing, that we petition the - President of the United States, our delegation to the Congress of the United States, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development and the Director of the Federal Housing Administration in Washington, D.C., not only to continue these programs but to expand and make them more economically realistic to the underprivileged.
