RESOLUTION: RENAMING THE SUBMARINE "CORPUS CHRISTI"

- WHEREAS the United States Navy gave the name "Corpus Christi" to a submarine launched in 1981; and
- WHEREAS the words "Corpus Christ" are Latin meaning literally "the body of Christ"; and
- WHEREAS the submarine was named after the city Corpus Christi, Texas; the city was founded in 1839 on the date of the Christian festival of Corpus Christi, hence its name; thus the submarine was named indirectly for the Christ; and
- WHEREAS naming an instrument of war after the Prince of Peace was an act of blasphemy, even if unintended and regardless of hopes that its missiles would serve as a deterrent to war; and
- WHEREAS our United States government officials' refusal to rename the vessel, once they became aware of the double meaning in "Corpus Christi", constitutes a national act of overt blasphemy; and
- WHEREAS Jesus, the Christ, said, "I tell you, on the Day of Judgement men will render account for every careless word they utter; for by your words you will be Justified, and by your words you will be condemned" (Matthew 12:36-37, RSV); he also said "Blessed are the peacemakers for they shall be called the children of God" (Matthew 5:9, K~V); he calls us to love one another; and
- WHEREAS as an example of his love for humanity, he allowed his body (Corpus Christi) to be broken for all people; and we remember his body broken for us in the sacrament of the Lord's Supper;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this Annual Meeting of the Connecticut Conference of the United Church of Christ express its intense disapproval of the naming of the submarine "Corpus Christi"; and
- BE IT FVRTHER RESOLVED that all individuals and churches within the Connecticut Conference are urged to write to their elected representatives in Washington requesting the submarine to be renamed; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Conference Minister and the Department of Church and Society take appropriate steps, by themselves and in concert with established groups of like mind, to bring about a name change for this submarine; and
- BE IT FVRTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Church and Society request all United States military services to avoid references to anything sacred to any religion when naming future weapons systems.
